The History of Poland Springs

Poland Springs has been a Maine company since 1845 when the Riccar family first began bottling the waters celebrated for their healing powers. After its founding, Poland Springs continued to grow in popularity, eventually winning awards at the Worlds Fairs in 1893 (Chicago) and 1904 (St. Louis) for the excellence of the water. In 1906, the first permanent spring and bottling facility was constructed on the site and the sales and production continued to grow. Poland Springs became a member of the Perrier Group (now Nestlé Water) in 1980.

As of 2004, Poland Springs has an incredible \$628 million annual sales in the United States.

I-95N to exit 63 (Gray/N. Gloucester). Turn left at US-202/ME-4/ME-26A. Turn right onto ME-26A. Continue to follow ME-26 (Shaker Road). Take a slight right at ME-122/Spring Water Road. Take a left at Poland Springs Drive.
